The US Academy will provide all US attendees' airfares, while the Korean Academy of Science and Technology will provide air transportation for all Korean attendees.

POSTER SESSION

Poster session have been scheduled to give symposium attendees who are not on the formal program the opportunity to present their own research. Please indicate on the response form, should you wish to participate in the optional poster session and provide us with a title and abstract for your poster to include in the symposium agenda book. Poster abstracts should be sent by **Thursday, April 30** and poster files should be sent by **Monday, May 18** via e-mail. Posters should be portrait style and size is 420mm(Width) x 594mm(Length).
